## **CROATIA**

## **NATIONAL REPORT 2003**

### I Network

The total length of motorway and expressway network of Croatia at the end of the year 2003 is 749,2 km, out of which 55 km are not tolled (Zagreb and Rijeka bypasses).

In 2003 several new sections were opened to traffic of a total length of 148,6 km on the following motorways: on the **Bosiljevo-Split** motorway the construction of two new sections Bosiljevo-Mala Kapela Tunnel and Gornja Ploca-Zadar 2 (of total length of 96 km) were completed in June according to schedule.

On the motorway **Zagreb-Gorican** the construction of section Breznicki Hum-Novi Marof was finished in June 2003 and in December 2003 the section Novi Marof-Varazdin was opened to traffic (of total length of 24,4 km) so this motorway is now fully completed.

As regards the motorway **Rijeka-Zagreb** two sections were completed and opened to traffic in 2003, which are the sections Kupjak-Vrbovsko and Vukova Gorica- Bosiljevo 2 (of total length of 28,2 km).

Motorways in the Republic of Croatia are operated by 3 companies:

HAC-"Croatian Motorways, Ltd" operates all motorways except for those that are under concession and two concession companies "BINA ISTRA" d.d. in Pula (operates the so-called Istrian "Y" motorway) and the company "Autocesta Rijeka Zagreb d.d. - "Rijeka-Zagreb Motorway".

### II Sections under construction

As of December 31, 2003 the construction was under way on totally 203,9 km of motorways and 29,7 km expressways on the following sections:

In 2004 the total number of 193,59 km of new motorways will be opened to traffic, as follows:

- 176,18 km on Bosilievo Split motorway in total,
- 3,71 km on Rupe Rijeka motorway in total,
- 13,7 km on Zagreb-Rijeka motorway in total.

Apart from the continuing the works on sections started last year new 42,6 km of motorways and 5,8 km of expressways shall start in 2004 as follows:

# III Financing and Investment

The total amount invested in construction of new motorway sections in 2003 was 6.905,13 billion kuna (908,56 million EUR), and the amount invested in the motorway sections already in operation was 122,6 millions kuna (16,11 million EUR).

Motorway construction in 2003 was mostly financed out of loans and toll revenues and beside these sources Hrvatske autoceste d.o.o. finances motorway construction out of fuel tax (0,60 HRK per liter).

Compared to the previous year the total traffic volume on motorways in 2003 was increased by 22,5 %.

Due to the increase in traffic volume, opening to traffic of new motorway sections and the slight adjustment of toll tariffs on all motorways in Croatia the total toll revenues have been increased by 26,2% compared with the preceding year.

### VI Toll rates

Considering the fact that the completion of the motorway network in Croatia is still under construction, open toll system is mainly used on constructed sections. However, once the network has been completed, closed toll system shall be applied on motorways with several entrances and exits

The tariff for light vehicles - passenger cars (I vehicle category) in closed toll system is 0.33 HRK/km (0.043 EUR/km), and in open toll system it is 0.29 HRK/km (0.038 EUR/km). The toll rate ratio between the I and IV vehicle category is 1:4.

The concessionary company BINA ISTRA has increased the tariffs on its network by 4 % in comparison with the year 2002. New tariffs came into effect on the 1st January 2003.

Compared to the last year the concessionary company Autocesta Rijeka-Zagreb has increased the tariffs on its semi-motorway sections in June 2003 by 50% in average, due to the fact that the open toll system, applied on toll plaza Lepenica, was transformed into closed system from Ostrovica to Vrbovsko section. On motorway sections the average increase in tolls in 2003 was 7%.

1739 traffic accidents occurred in 2003 out of which 45 accidents were with dead people and 475 accidents with injured people.

### VII Medium and Long Term Trends

In accordance with Transport Development Strategy of the Republic of Croatia, which was adopted by the Croatian Parliament, Croatia should have the total network of 1.365 km by 2013. In accordance with the Programme of the Republic of Croatia the total planned investment in motorway construction in 2001-2005 period amounts to 18,6 bn kuna (2,5 bn EURO), which comprises the construction of 450 km of motorways and 81 km of semi-motorways in the said period (to complete this programme the remaining 246,50 km of motorways and 50 km of semi-motorways are to be built).

The completion of Zagreb-Rijeka Motorway (remaining 13,7 km) is planned for June 2004. The construction of Rupe-Rijeka Motorway (remaining 17,2 km) is scheduled for 2004. The construction of the entire Bosiljevo-Split Motorway (remaining 215,6 km) has been scheduled for June 2005. Istrian "Y" semi-motorway is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2005 (total length of 50 km).

After 2005 the construction of 373 km of motorways and 61 km of semi-motorways shall be carried out and the design preparation for this project will be completed by 2005.
